

Disney Leadership Info 2018

The leadership of Kennesaw Mountain High will be visiting Disney. Here are the facts:

Dates: Feb 19 – Feb 23 (we will leave around 9:00 am). We will return around 6pm on Friday, Feb 23

Hotel: Disney's Port Orleans

Transportation: Coach Fox will be driving a Bussmaxx Luxury Bus. Transportation on site will be Disney rail and bus service.

Agenda: 19 Feb – Leave at 9am from bus port

20 Feb – All students and Chaperones will attend a Disney class. The rest of the day the students can play at several of the Disney's Park.

21 Feb All students and Chaperones will attend a Disney Class
During the day the students can play at several of the Disney's Park.
We will attend a KMHS vs Dr. Phillips baseball game

22 Feb A leadership meeting in the morning. The rest of the day the students can play at several of the Disney's Park.

23 Feb Leave approximately 9 am (Goal arrive at school around 5 PM)

NOTE: Students will be allowed to go from park to park w/o a chaperone as long as they are in a group of 4 or more and have called a chaperone prior to leaving a park and text again when they are at the next park. If a group fails they will lose this privilege and remain with chaperone at the park of the chaperones choice. Disney buses provide transportation from park to park free.

Cost: **Price based off 4 people to each room**

Hotel - \$219 .00 for four nights at Disney's Port Orleans Resort
- based on 4 per room

Tickets \$248.00 for 3 day hopper pass to the four major parks – Regular \$359

Disney classes \$ 30.00-one class free

Transportation \$ 70 (normally \$145 plus but Mane Link subsidizing)

Total \$567.00

*Note: Mane link paying for chaperones and driver cost of \$5300.00

Expectations: Cobb County Policies and Kennesaw Mountain High Schools rules and regulations will be enforced. Dress code is an expectation during all meetings. While in park, students are expected to follow all Cobb County/ KMHS and parent expectations concerning manners, dress, and integrity.
